

SUPERFORECASTING

Most predictions are not better than random Good predictions are possible



"The most important book on decision making since Daniel Kahneman's Thinking, Fast and Slow." -JASON 2WEIG, The Wall Street Journal

WHY PREDICTIONS ARE BAD?

People sell beliefs, agendas or intuition

Biases

Single idea - media

People do not own predictions

People do not revisit predictions

People do not measure predictions

* People are not trained in prediction methods

IMPROVING PREDICTIONS

Predictions should be clear and specific both in content and time

Predictions should be evaluated at the deadline

Predictions should be measured

* Prediction techniques

MEASURING PREDICTIONS

<u>Brier Score</u> - Difference between a predicted probability and the actual outcome (simplified)

Predict: 20%, outcome: 0, Brier score: 0.04 Predict: 20%, outcome: 1, Brier score: 0.64 Lower is better

Problem?

Sun will rise tomorrow: Predict: 100%, outcome: 1, Brier score: 0 Everyone predicts 1, so no predictive value

Brier Skill Score – Difference between your BS and BS of others

Problem?

Need other predictions of the same event

SUPERFORECASTING AND INVESTING - DIFFERENCES

Fundamental investors do not aim to predict exact macro or company events

May not matter if Apple EPS is \$2 or \$2.10

Knowing exact next Q revenues may not provide alpha

Closer probability of rare event may not be actionable enough (5% vs 8% product failure probability).

Mapping investing to forecasts is not simple

For good investment performance want to predict stock performance

Different timeframes

Forecasting works best within 1 year Investing may be looking at 5-10 years

SUPERFORECASTING AND INVESTING – POSSIBILITIES

FinPredictions

Attempt to create Superforecasting like forum for financial predictions

Closed: not enough interest

Learned lessons about differences

Investing + Superforecasting = \heartsuit ?

Questions that can be predicted and affect investments significantly?
